UniWin version 3.0 is used to manage all logistic actions that are linked to;

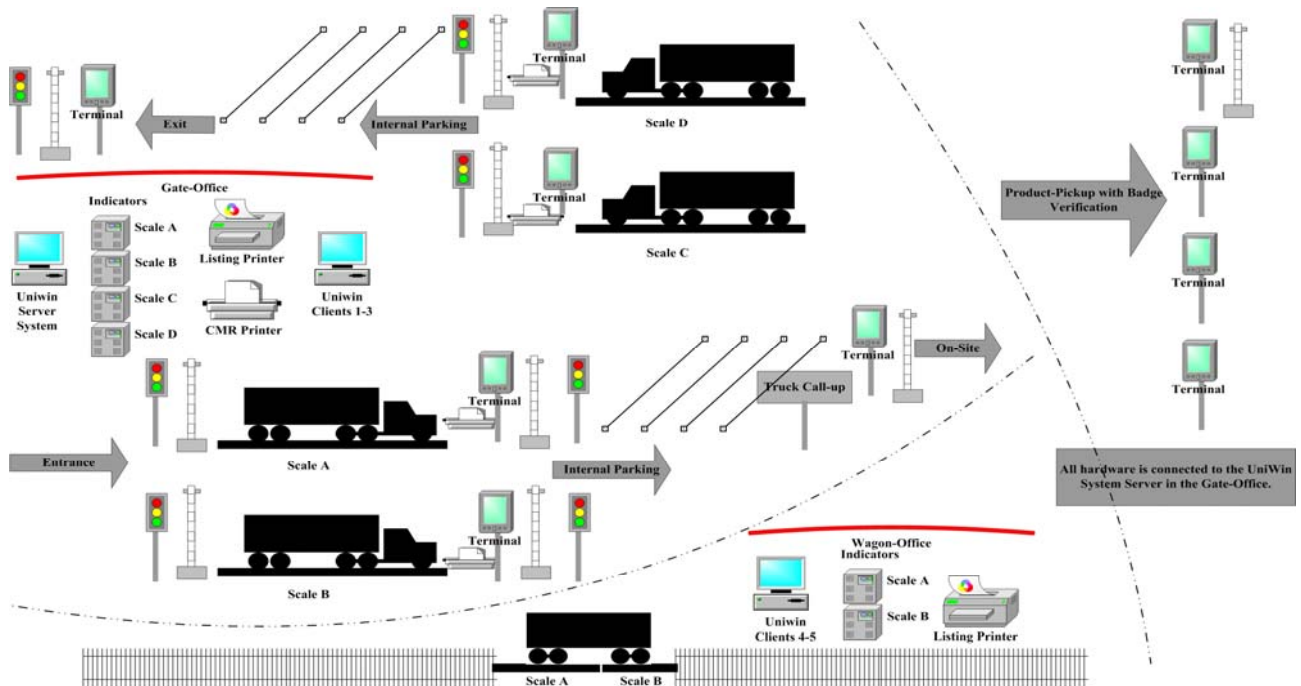
- Intake of scrap

Description:

- Incoming trucks are stopped at the entrance on scale A or B.
- The truckdriver positions his/her truck and reports at the gate-operator. Details are exchanged and a badge is issued.
- Back in his truck, the driver presents his badge at the terminal. The truck is weighed, a weightticket is printed and the barrier opens.
- The truckdriver parks his truck at the internal parking and waits until his badge No. is called-up.
- Afterwards the truckdriver follows its route to the (un)loading location. When loading his badge is checked at the different loadingdocks.
- Next the truckdriver follows its route to scale C or D. Again the badge is presented at the terminal. The truck is weighed and a weightticket with further instructions is printed. Furthermore the barrier is opened.
- Next, the truck is parked at the internal parking. The truckdriver reports at the gate-operator to handle all documents needed. His badge will be released to exit the factory.
- The truckdriver drives his vehicle to the exit. He presents his badge at the terminal. His/her badge is taken/swallowed by the terminal and the barrier is opened.
- The Trucks follows its route and the transactions is finished.

Other Features:

- UniWin controls the wagon-scale A,B,A+B and offers the possibility the execute weighings. At those moments wagon No's are checked with a special algorithm.
- UniWin continuously exchanges data with the IT-system of this steelmill. This communication is done via TCP/IP-Socket-to-Socket-connection.
